- FORMATIVE AIMS -

The Università per Stranieri “Dante Alighieri” of Reggio Calabria together with the Rotary Club of Reggio Calabria South “Parallelo 38” and the Rotary Club of “Roma Cassia” and with the patronage of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, start the II Edition of the 1st level Master’s degree in “Peace and cooperation politics for the development in the area of the Mediterranean”. The master’s objective is to form professionals experts in communication, in intermediation and in international counseling, for business and industrial activities in the Mediterranean ambit. The aim of the course is to equip the participants with theoretical and technical instruments essential for:

- *the comprehension of the geo-political assets which are in continuous evolution;*
- *the in depth study of the financial-economical (also relative to the internationalization of business) juridical, historical, political and diplomatic aspects of the existing relations among the states, part of the Union for the Mediterranean (UPM)*

An important part of the course will be aimed to the study of problems, growth models and sustainable development, with references in particular to those areas which present delays of a socio economical kind and which are committed to the inversion, at times structural, of this tendency. A particular attention will be given to the learning of two languages, Arabic at an elementary level, and English at an advanced level.

- DIDACTIC PLAN -

The Master’s activities are organized in 6 integrated courses, part of a formative path which has 1500 hours scheduled between didactic and integrative activities. (Seminar activities, internships and final thesis). The lessons will take place on Friday and Saturday at the Università per Stranieri “Dante Alighieri” 70% attendance to the courses and activities is compulsory. There will be six exams for the single subjects relatively to each integrated course, and the final exam with the discussion of the thesis of the Master, when these have been passed by the student he/she will be in possession of a University Master of 1st level in accordance to the law 341/90, M.D. 509/99 and M.D. (minister’s decree). 270/04 article 3 comma 9.

- ENTRY REQUIREMENTS -

The Master's degree is aimed to Italian students (20 places), European and non-European students (15 places) in possession of a three year degree or a four year one (old system), or with a specialist/teacher training school degree (new system) obtained within the Faculty of Law, Economy, Political Sciences, Letters and Philosophy or equivalent and relative degrees in Social Services Sciences, Economic Sciences and Legal studies, thus other study titles recognized as suitable by the norm in force. In order to access the course there will be a preliminary selection based on the titles possessed, and the student must pass a motivational interview and an English language test.

- TERMS OF PARTECIPATION -

The enrollment fee to the Master's degree is of € 2,800, which includes the regulation administration fee (€ 300,00); the Rotary International, Fondazione Roma - Mediterraneo and other organizations, reserve the right to bestow scholarships.

- INTERNSHIPS AND CARRER PROSPECTS -

An internship is included with the aim of, on one hand to put into practice what learnt during the courses, and on the other to favor a matching between job, demand and request through the involvement of NGO, Business, Import-Export consortiums, Private and public Institutions.
